Missionary of the Month

Covenant Pines Ministries is comprised of four unique camping experiences. Each ministry exists to encourage all campers to take a next step in Christian faith. They are owned and operated by the Covenant Churches of the Twin Cities. Over the past 50+ years Covenant Pines has expanded to do ministry for adults as well as youth and has become a year-round ministry, serving people of all ages in all seasons of the year. In 1992, the land just to the southwest of CPBC known as Silver Beach was purchased. It became our summer family area. In 2006, Adventurous Christians joined the family. AC had been owned and operated by the Northwest Conference of the Covenant Church for many years. In 2006 the Conference gave ownership of AC to Covenant Pines Bible Camp. Then, in 2008, we began running Day Camps in various locations around the Twin Cities. Together, Covenant Pines Bible Camp, Silver Beach, Adventurous Christians, and Day Camp makeup Covenant Pines Ministries.
